### **Kamo Primary School Awards**

As part of the lead up to the prizegiving I thought I would let parents and caregivers know which awards are given out and what they are for.

Some of these awards are a culmination of many years of hard work and determination.

#### **KPS Awards**

**Hannah Trophy** - Awarded to the most outstanding Year 6 student across all areas including academic, sporting, social, citizenship, initiative, perseverance, contributing to school events, and consistency.

**Sherman Award** - This award was instigated in 2005 in honour of Mr. Gary Sherman who died of cancer. Mr. Sherman was a very active member of the Home and School committee, and was president in 2004. He was a very innovative and proactive member of the school community who demonstrated initiative and enthusiasm. This is awarded for students who clearly demonstrate initiative, enthusiasm, and innovative approaches to school life.

**Sports Award** - Awarded to the most outstanding sports person across all aspects of sport and physical education.

**Kauri Awards** - Awarded to high achievers in Year 6, across all areas including academic, sporting, social, citizenship, initiative, perseverance, contributing to school events, and consistency.

**Griffin Awards** - Awarded to high achievers in each year group, across all areas including academic, sporting, social, citizenship, initiative, perseverance, contributing to school events, and consistency.

**Maori Leadership Award** - Awarded to a senior student for the following... Unique to Maori cultural principles such as - ako, whanaungatanga, tangata whenuatanga, manaakitanga, wananga, displaying good academic progress and improvement and is a role model of positive and supportive behaviour.

**ICT/e-Learning Awards** - Two awards are given out to students who display outstanding leadership and knowledge in e-Learning/ICT.

**Merit Awards** - Each teacher awards up to 6 students for outstanding achievement across all areas. These are students that demonstrate outstanding qualities or achievements. These are given out at a school assembly.
