School Donations Scheme

At Kamo Primary School, we have chosen to opt into the Ministry of Education's school donations scheme. This means that we do not ask for school donations for any of our students. Instead, we receive a grant from the government to cover this.

The Education and Training Act 2020 states that every person who is not an international student is entitled to free enrolment and free education at any state school. Therefore, we cannot charge domestic students a fee for enrolment, attendance or the delivery of the curriculum.

The only exception to this is for overnight school camps as under this scheme there is an option where we can ask for a fee for these.

School Fundraising

To fully fund any planned activities, the school needs more money than it is provided by the government. Fundraising at Kamo Primary School is managed by the Home and School Team who are a designated fundraising committee comprising of parents, caregivers, and whānau of students at our school.

They work to build resources and experiences for all students and aim to keep additional fees that are asked for as low as possible and fair for all families and whānau.

Sources of additional funds may include:

- student activity fees
- parent group fundraising
- student fundraising
- approaches to trusts and charities
- sponsorship
